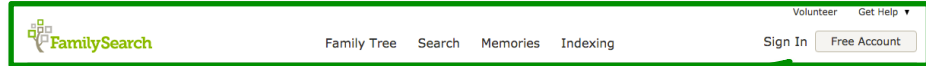


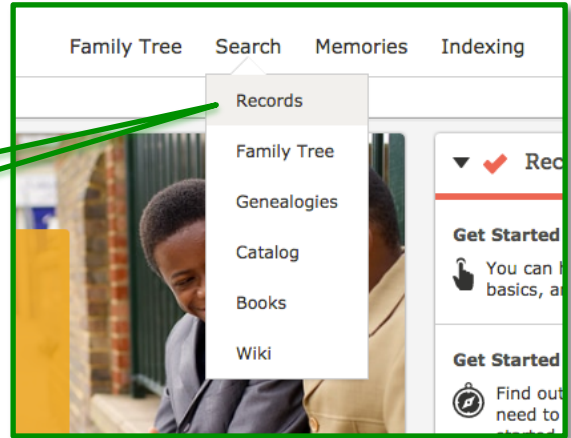
# Finding the U.S. Federal Censuses on FamilySearch.org

How can I find the U.S. Federal Censuses at FamilySearch.org?

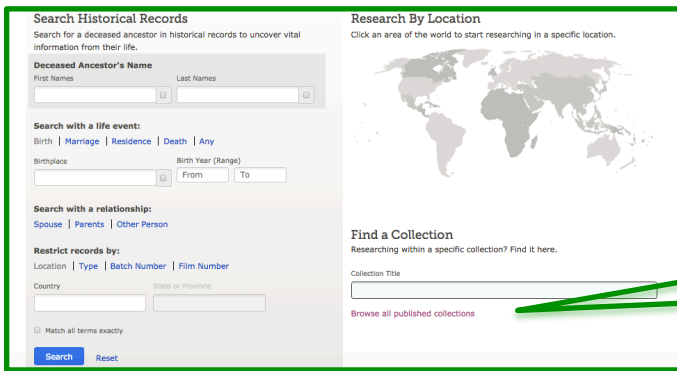


Go to FamilySearch.org and sign in.
